

SH Waterfront Homeowner Guidelines

These guidelines apply to any **SH homeowner** who chooses to volunteer their time to clean or maintain areas along the waterfront.

Guidelines

- **Homeowner Participation** — If you choose to clean any part of the waterfront, the community appreciates your effort to help keep the area clean, safe, and beautiful.
- **ARC Form Requirement** — You must submit an ARC form for the specific date and time you plan to perform any cleaning or maintenance.
- **City Violations** — SH is not responsible for any city/Army Corp/Wetlands violations that may occur. The homeowner assumes full responsibility for any violations and associated fees.
- **Tree & Branch Trimming** — Homeowners may only trim or cut back trees and branches that are the property of SH. No trimming of cityowned or protected vegetation is permitted.
- **Debris Removal** — All limbs, branches, and debris created by your work must be removed within 24 hours.
- **Equipment Responsibility** — Any equipment used is the sole responsibility of the homeowner. SH is not liable for damage, loss, or malfunction of personal equipment.
- **Personal Safety** — SH is not responsible for any personal injuries that may occur during volunteer work.
- **Chemical Use** — Spraying of any chemicals, herbicides, pesticides, or treatments is strictly prohibited.
